- Eligible for licensure with the Texas State Board of Pharmacy
 - All licensing tests must be attempted no later than June 20, 2024
- Official college(s) of pharmacy transcript(s)
- Letter of intent
- Curriculum Vitae
- Include completed and anticipated advanced pharmacy practice experiences
- Three letters of recommendation
 - Direct patient care APPE preceptors recommended
- GPA \geq 3.0
- Selected applicants will be interviewed
